THE PURPOSE OF THIS

Spiritual Journey

The purpose of this 21 Day Spiritual Journey is to help direct and unite our church family in prayer and to renew our commitment to our mission. Our mission is to **KNOW** Jesus Christ, **GROW** to Follow Jesus, and **GO** multiply followers of Jesus.

We are embarking on a journey as a church which is not simply about building a building or merely about raising money, but it is about expanding our ability to live out our mission. As we go through God's Word for the next 21 days may we be reminded that we have the **SAME MISSION** with a **NEW OPPORTUNITY** for an **EXPANDED LEGACY**.

WHAT DO I DO?

1. *Pray* every day for our mission using the Scriptures and summary as a guide
2. *Meditate* on God's Word using each day's verses
3. *Act* on the word of day (**in bold**) by putting it into practice each day
4. *Memorize* the first Scripture verse each week as a way to commit our mission to heart

"...and how from infancy you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus. All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness."

DAY 1

Praise God for his Word that gives us the ability to **KNOW** him and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness. Today, what can you do to know God more fully?

DAY 2

Pray that as a church we will continue to grow in the **GRACE** and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. Today, how can you let God's grace affect how you view yourself and others?

II Peter 3.18

DAY 3

Pray that we **TRUST** in Jesus who brought light into the world and through whom all things were made. Today, how can you trust Jesus in the midst of your life's joys, struggles, and trials?

John 1.1-3

DAY 4

Pray today that as a church we will seek and **FIND** God in the midst of the mission we are set out on. Today, what are some ways you are seeking God to live out your life's mission and your participation in the mission of Eastport Bible Church?

Proverbs 8.17

DAY 5

Pray that we know what **LOVE** is, because Jesus laid down his life for us. Today, what is a specific way that you can love someone else the way Jesus first loved us?

I John 3.6

DAY 6

Praise God today for the eternal life we can have through knowing Jesus Christ. Today, do you acknowledge that Jesus is the way and the **TRUTH** and the life and no one comes to the Father except through him?

John 17.3

DAY 7

Pray that we will **OBEY** God's Word as we strive to know him more fully and live out his mission for our lives. Today, find one truth from God's Word that you are actively going to live out as you go through the day.

WEEK TWO: GROW

WEEK TWO MEMORY VERSE: II Timothy 2.15
"Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth."

DAY 8

Pray that we will all **GROW** in God's Word. Today, reflect on some of the ways you have grown as a result of spending time in God's Word.

DAY 10

Pray that we will **SEEK** God and hide his Word in our hearts. Today, what is something God has taught you in the past 10 days through memorizing our verses?

Psalms 119.10-11

DAY 11

Pray that we will turn our **HEARTS** towards God and not towards our own gain. Today, what is one thing that we can give up to live more open-handedly towards God?

DAY 12

Pray that we will not conform to the patterns of the world, but that we will be **TRANSFORMED** through faith and trust in Jesus. Today, what is a pattern of the world that has captured your time and attention?

How can you transform it?

DAY 13

Pray that as a church we will be strengthened in the faith and that we will overflow with **THANKFULNESS**. Today, list 10 things that you are thankful for. If there are people on that list, how can you tell them you are thankful for them today?

Colossians 2.6-7

DAY 14

Praise God today that we have each been given a **GIFT** by God in order that the Body of Christ may be built up. Today, what is your gift? How are you using it to built up the work that God is doing here at Eastport Bible Church?

WEEK THREE MEMORY VERSE: II Corinthians 5:19-20

We implore you on Christ’s behalf: Be reconciled to God.”

DAY 15

II Timothy 2:1-2

DAY 18

Pray for those in your life who do not know Jesus and that God will give us the boldness to invite them to **FOLLOW** Jesus. Today, who is one person that you can boldly invite to follow Jesus?

Mark 1:16-18

DAY 19

Pray that God will give us all that we need for every good **WORK** he wants to do in us and through us. Today, what do you believe is the work that God has called you to do in your life and at Eastport Bible Church?

II Corinthians 9:8

DAY 20

Pray that we will seek God boldly and put our **TRUST** in him who is able to do the impossible. Today, what is a bold, audacious, crazy idea that you have thought was impossible? How can you trust God to do the impossible?

Matthew 21:21-22

DAY 21

Pray that we will be a passionate community of believers who are excited to **PROCLAIM** the good news of Jesus. Today, what is your role in our church’s mission to proclaim the good news of Jesus to our entire community?
